

Record of Proceedings – April 25, 2016

Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Hagemeyer, Schaefer and Williams present. President Williams opened the meeting and we recited the Pledge of Allegiance. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$7,179.23 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 9957-9972 and Vouchers 15-2016 and 16-2016 totaling \$9,368.43 were presented for approval. Hagemeyer made motion, seconded by Schaefer, to pay bills as presented. Motion carried.

FROM THE FLOOR:

Nothing at this time.

ROADS REPORT:

From our Roads Supervisor, Allen Stanforth:

- Jurgensen won the county paving contract. We will be paving Ross Road this summer at an approximate cost of \$82,575.
- Replacement of culvert at 1000 Ward-Koebel Road is complete.
- No response from residents at 6741 Ross Road regarding our request to replace their culvert. They have not yet picked up our certified letter. Allen will research possibilities with the county engineer.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

The Visioning Workshop at King's Domain on April 21 for the I71-Wilmington Road Area Plan was well-attended. They broke out into brainstorming sessions, and results will be shared at the next meeting at Olive Branch United Methodist Church on May 5 at 6:30pm.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Schaefer, Bob Wysong and Tyler Webb met with Speaker of the House Cliff Rosenberger last week trying to get property donated by Clarksville to build a burn tower in Clarksville at the old Valley Steel site, behind the fire house. This would be run by Sinclair College. Mr. Rosenberger is asking for \$825,000 from the state to build the tower, and many surrounding counties will be able to train there.
- Received a letter from the Warren County Engineer's Office reminding truckers that truck weight/size limits will be strictly enforced by the sheriff's office. This is to help keep our county roads safer. Special permits can be issued for large loads.

As there was no further business, Schaefer made motion, seconded by Hagemeyer to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:27pm.
