- We sent a bill to the J.K. Meurer Corporation for plowing and salting this winter
- The county commissioners denied a proposed text amendment to the rural zoning code as regards wedding venues
- There will be a Special Election on May 7 for the Clinton-Massie Local Schools 5-year, .5% income tax. The township hall is the only poll that will be open in the township for this special election.
