

Record of Proceedings – December 8, 2014
Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Schaefer, Hagemeyer and Williams present. President Schaefer opened the meeting. All joined in the Pledge of Allegiance. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$4773.61 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 9591-9601 totaling \$62,969.98 were presented for approval.

- No response from Chemical Labs regarding salt delivery.
- Another issue on Indian Lakes Blvd. Can't push snow off cul-de-sac due to obstructions placed by owner of #807.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

If Ft. Ancient is declared a World Heritage Site, visitors could increase by tenfold. Current visitors number approximately 26,000 per year. There will be a presentation on December 19 at 9:30pm in the Warren County Commissioners' Meeting Room.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Issue on Fordyce Road reported by the mail carrier. She could not get to mailboxes due to vehicles parked in the roadway. We may install a "No Parking" sign at the turn-around.
- David and Stephanie Brausch are appealing to the Board of Zoning Appeals on December 17 at 6:30pm in the commissioners' meeting room. Their appeal is based on the definition of "agricultural use".
