

Record of Proceedings – June 24, 2019
Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Fisher, Schaefer and Hagemeyer present. We opened the meeting by inviting all to join in the Pledge of Allegiance. Receipts of \$3,414.11 since our last meeting were reported and filed for audit. Warrants 10807-10822 and Vouchers 29, 30 and 31-2019 totaling \$12,623.45 were presented for approval. Hagemeyer made motion, seconded by Fisher to pay bills as presented. Motion carried. Minutes from the previous meeting were approved as presented.

FROM THE FLOOR:

- Reminder to keep car and home doors locked as break-ins are taking place
- There have been multiple accidents at Middleboro Road and State Route 350. Resident wonders if the state could put up a flashing yellow light or other cautionary sign? Jason will forward the concern to ODOT
- Continued concern about public nuisance at 166 Clarksville Road. We will open bids to clean yard of debris at our meeting on July 8. Per ORC 505.87, we can contract to have the trash removed from around the home and have the yard mowed. Only the county can figure out the disposition of the house and the vehicles.

ROADS REPORT:

From our Roads Supervisor, Allen Stanforth:

- Pre-construction meeting for our summer paving projects was Wednesday, June 12 at the county engineer's office. Road affected is Strout from Senior to bike trail and from Middleboro to 22/3. No date is set yet
- Allen has been mowing as weather permits.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Our \$25,000 CD at LCNB is now invested for 2 years at 1.95% interest.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Our \$75,000 CD at LCNB matures on July 5. Karen will call and reinvest at the best rate possible
- Congressman Steve Chabot will hold a town hall meeting here on June 28 from 4-5pm. Everyone is welcome
- Cargill won the bid with Warren County for the salt contract for the 2019-2020 winter season. Rate is \$84.40 per ton. Schaefer made motion, seconded by Hagemeyer, to purchase up to 250 tons of salt. Motion carried.
- We received a notification from the FCC for a new communications tower at 3174 Middleboro Road
- Fiscal Officer will present the township budget for 2020 at our meeting on July 8.

As there was no further business, Schaefer made motion, seconded by Hagemeyer to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:28pm.
