

Record of Proceedings – July 27, 2015
Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Schaefer, Williams and Hagemeyer present. President Hagemeyer opened the meeting. All joined in the Pledge of Allegiance. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$7353.45 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 9757-9771 and Vouchers 29-2015 and 30-2015 totaling \$11,183.50 were presented for approval.

FROM THE FLOOR:

- Lt. Miller reports that meth is returning to our area. Call the Sheriff's Office if you see any 2-liter Mt. Dew bottles with a tube sticking out of the top.
- 4-wheeler speeding on roads continues.
- Resident on Settlemyre reports an issue with CenturyLink high-speed internet. As far as we know, they are the only provider on that road, and she will have to keep working with them. Also, she did mention the poor condition of several properties in the neighborhood. She was advised to personally call and report these to the county zoning department.

ROADS REPORT:

From our Roads Supervisor, Allen Stanforth:

- Paving is complete on Gum Grove and Shawhan-Ayres Roads, and he is berming on Gum Grove.
- We have a punch list of small items to be completed on Lisle Lane before the township takes it over. They are complying.
- Allen is concerned about Meurer Estates (off of Strout) in the event of building. His concern is that the road and culverts will be installed properly.
- Dispatch called with a tree down report on Olive Branch Road on July 21. Allen told Dispatcher to report that he was coming and for Wayne Township to disregard.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- We noticed a \$500 charge from Wayne Township Fire Department for responding to a tree down on June 16. Allen had responded that he was enroute. Chief Scherer is not available this week; we will discuss with him when he returns. Also, Allen often gets calls to handle issues on county and state roads.
- Abandoned property at 8921 Arrowcreek Road in Oregonia has been mowed. We will pay contractor and certify costs to the auditor.
- Zoning Department will be sending a letter to owner of 7276 Shawhan-Ayres Road regarding pallets and lumber in the right-of-way.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Warren County would like to do direct deposit with the fire district. Williams will mention at the next meeting and try to get the ball rolling.
- Soil and Water Department was called out last week to inspect a property on Arrowcreek Drive.
- Resident applied for a building permit on Lincoln Road and a "Washington Township Park" was discovered in the records. That should have been removed long ago, and the family can go ahead and build.
- Zoning violation was reported at 3914 Nicholson Road – residents are living in a recreational vehicle.

As there was no further business, Schaefer made motion, seconded by Williams to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:53pm.
