

Record of Proceedings – June 8, 2015
Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Schaefer, Williams and Hagemeyer present. President Hagemeyer opened the meeting. All joined in the Pledge of Allegiance. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$19,040.94 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 9728-9733 totaling \$5,878.41 were presented for approval.

FROM THE FLOOR:

Lt. Miller attended from the Sheriff's office. Issues of 4-wheelers and bike races were briefly discussed.

ROADS REPORT:

From our Roads Supervisor, Allen Stanforth:

- Installed two culverts on Strout Road between State Route 22/3 and Middleboro Road.
- Cell tower to be installed on Fisher Road: a third-party road inspection will be done before work begins, and after work is completed.
- We received a quote from Agro Chem for tanks for hauling and storing. K.E. Rose would retrofit trucks separately.
- Stanforth will be out of office on June 11 and 12, and has a back-up lined up in the event of an emergency.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- Williams reported on the Ft. Ancient meeting last weekend. It was interesting. The Adeena tribe lived here from 1-400 A.D., followed by the Mound Builders up until 1400 A.D., followed by the American Indians until 1850. There are 120 acres in the mound area; 775 acres in the park. The mounds were mostly ceremonial. In order for Ft. Ancient to be declared a World Heritage Site, all of the other nine sites in Ohio have to meet certain requirements as well. This will be a long process, if it happens at all.
- Chemical Labs may pursue legal action due to salt we reserved but did not pick up.
- Property at 8921 Arrowcreek Drive has not been mowed this season. The company that handled it last season was told they were not needed this year. Motion made by Schaefer, seconded by Williams to post on the door and send certified letters to the owners declaring the property a nuisance. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Schaefer received a complaint regarding several neglected yards on Settlemyre and Ward-Koebel Roads. He advised the resident to call Warren County Zoning and place a complaint. They are 694 Settlemyre, 857 Settlemyre, 938 Settlemyre, 960 Settlemyre, and 1070 Ward-Koebel. We will also email them.
- Our \$25,000 Certificate of Deposit will mature on June 25. A current special rate for 22 months is .7%. We will call and try to lock in that rate. Motion made by Williams, seconded by Schaefer. Motion carried.
- Notice received from the Warren County Engineer's Office regarding a triathlon in the township on June 21, and another on August 2. Please be aware of bike riders and exercise caution.

As there was no further business, Schaefer made motion, seconded by Williams to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:50pm.
