From our Roads Supervisor, Allen Stanforth:

- Will be receiving approximately 150 tons of salt from last year's contract with Detroit Salt
- Now that snow season is about over, Allen will prepare a bill for clearing/salting the Meurerfield Estates subdivision, per our agreement with them.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- Warren County Engineer's Dinner was held March 8. Later this year, the county will install new pilings on Mather's Mill hill to stabilize.
- Fisher attended the Warren County Health District Advisory Board meeting last week. There will be grants available to repair septic systems for low income families. We will place the application on our homepage.
- Dominic Brigano will be filling an unexpired term on the Board. They meet once a year, and the next meeting will be March 5, 2019.
