

Record of Proceedings – March 13, 2017
Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Schaefer, Hagemeyer and Williams present. President Schaefer opened the meeting and we recited the Pledge of Allegiance. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$0 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 10199 - 10203 totaling \$1,995.98 were presented for approval. Williams made motion, seconded by Hagemeyer to pay bills as presented. Motion carried.

FROM THE FLOOR:

- Resident attended from Senior Road on behalf of fellow residents expressing concerns about the closure of Strout Road at Senior. The county is replacing a bridge and has it totally closed. Warren County Dispatch has been notified of the closure.
- Resident also raised question about a neighbor's dogs who have killed chickens and turkeys in the neighborhood. Warden was called, and neighbor was cited for failure to control. If dogs threaten resident on their property, resident may protect himself.

ROADS REPORT:

From our Roads Supervisor, Allen Stanforth:

Strout Road culvert was replaced last week with Warren County Engineer's help. It was a big job and the help was much appreciated. We will send a letter of appreciation. Culvert is currently graveled, and Allen will cover with hot mix when the plants open.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- Schaefer attended the Public Health District meeting last Tuesday. Heroin deaths are very high in the county.
- Warren County Regional Planning Commission had scheduled to make their presentation to the Trustees regarding the I71-Wilmington Road Area Plan on March 27. They will have to reschedule.
