

**Record of Proceedings – March 26, 2018**  
**Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio**

The regular meeting was held with Hagemeyer, Fisher and Schaefer present. President Hagemeyer opened the meeting by inviting all to join in the Pledge of Allegiance. Receipts of \$11,862.26 since our last meeting were reported and filed for audit. Warrants 10471-10504 and Vouchers 14, 15 and 16-2018 totaling \$45,370.00 were presented for approval. Schaefer made motion, seconded by Fisher to pay bills as presented. Motion carried. Minutes from the previous meeting were approved as presented.

**FROM THE FLOOR:**

Marcie Longenecker of the Treasurer of State's Cincinnati office attended and announced that our financials are now available to the public on the OhioCheckbook.com website. The treasurer's office is trying to have all records of public entities available online. **ROADS REPORT:**

From our Roads Supervisor, Allen Stanforth:

- Warren County Engineer's Office has asked us if we wish to participate in the salt purchase program for next year. Allen would like to request 250 tons, just in case. We are not obligated to purchase the whole amount. We currently have not quite 300 tons on hand. Fisher made motion, seconded by Schaefer to participate. Motion carried.
- Warren County Engineer's Office will not be sponsoring a chip seal program for roads this year due to quality concerns.
- Took tractor and rotary cutter to auction today. Received new tractor from dealer.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

Warren County Township Association members reviewed scholarship applications and chose five to forward to the Prosecutor's Office for final review. They will choose two recipients of the \$1000 scholarship.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

- Fisher relayed notice of speeding in Hopewell Meadows to the sheriff's office.
- Ohio Division of Liquor Control asked if trustees have any issues with the liquor permits in our jurisdiction. The answer was no.
- Zoning violation at 376 Clarksville Road – junk vehicle and trash
- Zoning violation at 3580 Middleboro – no permit applied
- Warren County Zoning will hold a variance hearing on April 10 at 6:30pm regarding setback at 9109 State Route 22/3
- As it is the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Ohio Scenic Rivers Act, we were requested to sign a resolution in support. Trustees did so.
- Doney presented permanent appropriation resolution for 2018 – motion made by Schaefer, seconded by Fisher. Resolution passed and Doney will forward to county auditor.

As there was no further business, Schaefer made motion, seconded by Fisher to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:35pm.
