

Record of Proceedings – May 23, 2016

Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Hagemeyer, Schaefer and Williams present. President Williams opened the meeting and we recited the Pledge of Allegiance. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$6,945.83 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 9979-9991 and Vouchers 19-2016 and 20-2016 totaling \$8,511.26 were presented for approval. Hagemeyer made motion, seconded by Schaefer, to pay bills as presented. Motion carried.

FROM THE FLOOR:

Resident brought up the condition of 702 Middleboro Road. The yard is full of vehicles, trash and other items. They have been warned in the past by the county zoning department. Doney will check with the zoning department to find out status.

ROADS REPORT:

From our Roads Supervisor, Allen Stanforth:

- Owners of 6741 Ross Road applied for and received a culvert permit. Allen expects to replace it very soon.
- Pre-construction paving contract meeting with Jurgenson was held on May 11. They will begin in Warren County on June 1.
- Resident in Indian Lakes subdivision advised us of excess grit once again. As Allen has been busy ditching and mowing, he will sweep again as soon as possible.
- Allen will be researching the topic of applying a top coat over blacktop.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- Clarksville Road may open by June 10.
- Wilmington Road just west of Ward-Koebel Road is estimated by the county to close June 20 for approximately 12 weeks for a bridge replacement.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Resident complained about 8115 Strout Road in Clarksville. It has not been mowed. Hagemeyer made motion, seconded by Schaefer to begin our proceedings to declare it a nuisance. Motion carried. Hagemeyer will first call the prosecutor's office to see if this 6+ acre lot is covered by our normal procedure.
- Kokosing will be hauling concrete in July from the Jeremiah Morrow Bridge along Middleboro Road to Camp Joy.
- Roads Supervisor will be presenting his proposed projects/budget for 2017 at one of our June meetings.

As there was no further business, Hagemeyer made motion, seconded by Schaefer to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:27pm.
