

Record of Proceedings – May 9, 2016
Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Hagemeyer, Schaefer and Williams present. President Williams opened the meeting and we recited the Pledge of Allegiance. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$4,447.53 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 9973-9978 totaling \$10,308.26 were presented for approval. Hagemeyer made motion, seconded by Schaefer, to pay bills as presented. Motion carried.

FROM THE FLOOR:

Salem Township Fire Chief William Harrison gave his department's report for March. They continue to be busy, and continue to pursue training opportunities. Several residents have had issues with high insurance rates due to distance from the fire department. He encourages residents to call him at 513-340-5249 if he can be of assistance.

ROADS REPORT:

From our Roads Supervisor, Allen Stanforth:

Owner of 6741 Ross Road did not pick up the certified letter we mailed on April 12. We have contacted the Prosecutor's office for information on how to proceed. It is very important to replace this collapsed pipe before we pave Ross Road this summer. We are waiting on an answer. Generally, the cost of a culvert pipe is about \$350. Resident pays for the pipe, and the township customarily installs for free and donates one scoop of gravel to cover.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- Hagemeyer gave overview of the Warren County Regional Planning Commission I-71/Wilmington Road Area Plan meeting on May 5 at Olive Branch Church. Next one will be on June 2, and topic will be vision statement and principles.
