

Record of Proceedings – November 10, 2014
Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Schaefer, Williams and Hagemeyer present. President Schaefer opened the meeting. All joined in the Pledge of Allegiance. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$20,034.83 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 9573-9580 totaling \$13,092.64 were presented for approval.

FROM THE FLOOR:

ROADS REPORT:

From our Roads Supervisor, Allen Stanforth:

- Donated sirens are unhooked, and Stanforth will pick them up Wednesday.
- Will be digging Arabian Run damaged spot on Thursday. Was reviewed by the county today.
- Resident at 7657 Stable View Court has placed rocks in his ditch line. It is decorative, and doesn't seem to be an immediate problem, but we will keep an eye on it. Concern is that the area could heave up and impede the flow of water. We will write a letter to the resident, reminding them that the ditch line is the township right-of-way.
- May eliminate 50 gallon gas tank in the shop as the gas gets stale before it is totally used.
- Allen will be on vacation next week.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

None at this time.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Warren County Township Association Dinner will be held on November 13. Hagemeyer, Schaefer and Stanforth plan on attending.
- At their quarterly meeting on November 18, the Warren County Regional Planning Commission plans to announce that Ft. Ancient has been designated a "World Heritage" site. Meeting is open to the public and begins at 5:30pm. (NOTE: We since found out that it is being considered as a World Heritage site. The process is underway.)
- Resident on Fordyce Road made the request that we allow them to chain across the Camp Joy right-of-way on their property to stop people from driving back there who should not. They would provide keys to the lock to the Kaesemeyers and to Camp Joy. Trustees have no issue with this, and would just like their acknowledgement of the situation and their approval. Doney will send letters.
