

Record of Proceedings – October 10, 2016

Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Williams and Hagemeyer present. President Williams opened the meeting and we recited the Pledge of Allegiance. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$0 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 10084-10091 totaling \$10,623.83 were presented for approval. Hagemeyer made motion, seconded by Williams to pay bills as presented. Motion carried.

FROM THE FLOOR:

Question was asked about process of legal proceedings against owner of 702 Middleboro Road. The yard continues to be junk-filled. Doney will check with Adam Nice who is handling the case.

ROADS REPORT:

From our Roads Supervisor, Allen Stanforth:

Hickory Woods subdivision, formally Meurer Field Estates off of Strout Road: Warren County Engineer asked us if we have a Snow Removal Agreement with the owner of the plat. There are now residents who live in that plat who have schoolchildren, and we are concerned about school buses and emergency vehicles getting through in bad weather. Williams pointed out that if the road is not dedicated and plowed, the buses have the option of not driving on it. Stanforth was told that the original developer of the plat still owns the roads. Mailboxes for the subdivision are on Strout Road. We will endeavor to find the owner of these roadways and send a certified letter with a Snow Removal Agreement for their completion.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- Our Fire/EMS contract with Wayne Township will expire at the end of the year. A one-year renewal with no changes was presented. Hagemeyer made motion, seconded by Williams, to do so. Motion carried.
- Noise control ordinance discussion: Doney presented a rough draft for the Trustees to consider. It was based very loosely on ordinances from two local agencies that were shared with us. This would affect only those businesses with a “D” class liquor license. Questions were discussed and will be forwarded to the Prosecutor’s office for their legal opinion.
- Warren County Regional Planning Commission held an I-71/Wilmington Road Citizens’ Advisory Council meeting at Olive Branch United Methodist Church on October 6. It was well-attended. Chapters 1 and 2 of the draft area plan were discussed. Next topic was possible style of development to maintain our rural ambience. Next meeting will be November 3 at 6:30pm at the church.

NEW BUSINESS:

Warren County Township Association Annual Dinner will be held November 10 at Armco Park at 6pm. Hagemeyer, Williams, Schaefer and Stanforth will attend. Cost is \$15 per person. Doney will RSVP.

As there was no further business, Hagemeyer made motion, seconded by Williams to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:44pm.
