

Record of Proceedings – October 22, 2018
Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Hagemeyer, Fisher and Schaefer present. President Hagemeyer opened the meeting by inviting all to join in the Pledge of Allegiance. Receipts of \$28,217.51 since our last meeting were reported and filed for audit. Warrants 10636-10649 and Vouches 52, 53 and 54-2018 totaling \$17,407.30 were presented for approval. Schaefer made motion, seconded by Fisher to pay bills as presented. Motion carried. Minutes from the previous meeting were approved as presented.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Clinton-Warren Joint Fire District will hold a Trunk-or-Treat event at the fire house on October 30 from 5-8pm. We will clear snow from the lot this winter. They have three newer interns. Since the last meeting, there have been 58 EMS and 26 fire runs.
