

Record of Proceedings – October 26, 2015

Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Schaefer, Williams and Hagemeyer present. President Hagemeyer opened the meeting. All joined in the Pledge of Allegiance. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$7,577.60 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 9827-9837 and Vouchers 41-2015 and 42-2015 totaling \$7,711.35 were presented for approval.

FROM THE FLOOR:

- Home at 702 Middleboro Road is still in bad shape; we will ask Zoning to re-check
- Homeowner received support from Salem Township Fire Department regarding their ISO rating to decrease the home insurance rate
- Resident at 7276 Shawhan-Ayers was parked in roadway again this morning. He picked up certified letter on October 23.

ROADS REPORT:

From our Roads Supervisor, Allen Stanforth:

- Dead end at Gum Grove Road was surveyed and the Warren County Engineer's Office installed a culvert. It is now a public turn-around. Maintenance from this point forward is responsibility of the owner.
- Allen picked up a deer Sunday morning on Flint Trail.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- The Citizens Advisory Committee requested by the Warren County Regional Planning Commission to discuss the I-71 and Wilmington Road planning will meet December 3 at 6:30pm at Olive Branch United Methodist Church. Open public sessions will follow at a later date.
- Vacant Lot #9 in Pennington Estates has not been mowed all season. Owner picked up letter on October 23.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Warren County Township Association Annual Dinner will be held November 5 at 7pm. Hagemeyer, Williams, Schaefer and Stanforth will attend.
- Our next meeting on November 9 will be at 7pm.
- Letter received from local residents regarding noise from truckers' use of the jake brake along Wilmington Road just east of Ward-Koebel Road, coming down a small hill. They would like us to forward their request for a sign to the county engineer's office. We will do so.
- Warren County Rural Zoning Commission will hold a public hearing on November 3 at 6:30pm. Topic is text amendments and signage standards.
- The commissioners will meet November 10 at 9:30am regarding the Gateway North Plan (I-75 at Route 63).
- Received letter from Liquor Control asking for input regarding transfer of Chief's Lake liquor license from previous owner to new owner. Trustees had no objections.

As there was no further business, Schaefer made motion, seconded by Williams to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:34pm.
