

Record of Proceedings – October 27, 2014
Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Williams and Hagemeyer present. Vice-President Hagemeyer opened the meeting. All joined in the Pledge of Allegiance. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$63,790.87 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 9560-9572 and Vouchers 37-2014 and 38-2014 totaling \$86,371.20 were presented for approval.

FROM THE FLOOR:

- Lt. Miller of the Sheriff's office stopped by. Reminded all of approach of holiday and the usual increase in thefts.
- Tornado sirens not yet on site; waiting to be unhooked by electric company.
- Boundary reflectors on State Route 350 at Gum Grove are down. Resident was advised to contact ODOT.
- Dave Brausch gave report on his composting business. He is spreading approximately 600 acres per day, plowing in immediately, and hopes to finish within a week.
- Arabian Run resident concerned about road damage in front of home being built on Lot 9. Road was accepted by the township in January 2013. Allen will pursue digging/patching to prevent further damage. Legal question regarding responsibility is pending.

ROADS REPORT:

From our Roads Supervisor, Allen Stanforth:

- Composition of salt from Chemical Labs is fairly equal to Morton Salt. It does contain an anti-caking agent. Price will be \$100/ton plus \$8 delivery; request purchase order by October 31. Williams made motion, seconded by Hagemeyer, to purchase 150 tons. Motion carried.
- Henderson meeting was held on October 24. New truck will be delivered in the Thanksgiving timeframe.

NEW BUSINESS:

- ODOT regular meeting on topic of public transportation will be held on October 31 at 10am in Lebanon.
- Massie Township Comprehensive Plan will be discussed October 28 at 6:30pm.

- Our next meeting will be at 7pm as Daylight Savings Time ends.

As there was no further business, Williams made motion, seconded by Hagemeyer, to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:45pm.
