

Record of Proceedings – September 24, 2018
Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Hagemeyer, Fisher and Schaefer present. President Hagemeyer opened the meeting by inviting all to join in the Pledge of Allegiance. Receipts of \$7,711.83 since our last meeting were reported and filed for audit. Warrants 10615-10628 plus Vouchers 47, 48 and 49-2018 totaling \$6,906.66 were presented for approval.
