

Record of Proceedings – June 9, 2008

Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Schaefer, Dare, and Williams present. President Schaefer called the meeting to order. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$8690.27 were reported and filed for audit. Warrants 7536 thru 7544 totaling \$5101.95 were reviewed and signed.

WARREN COUNTY PROSECUTOR'S REPORT

Prosecutor Rachael Hutzel attended and passed out the *2007 Annual Report to the Citizens of Warren County* and copies of the Warren County Prosecutor Newsletter for May-June 2008. Their office has 25 lawyers who prosecute cases for the county. In 2007, they had 26,400 court cases, with a very high percentage of convictions. Over \$34,000,000 was collected last year in child support; only \$1 is spent for every \$13 collected.

ROADS REPORT:

Our Roads Supervisor, Liston Burton, gave his report on the roads.

- County had meeting last week at Hopewell Meadows with builder; hopefully he will begin to address drainage ditch issues.
- County will replace culvert at Lincoln Rd. and at Shawhan-Ayers/350 next week.
- Bids were opened from two bidders for blacktopping approx. 1.8 miles of township roads: low bid was from Trampler Brothers.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Complaint from neighbor regarding waist-high grass at 9318 Arrowcreek Drive, Oregonia. Will seek opinion from prosecutor's office regarding ORC 505.87.
- New owners of Hall's Market seek to have liquor license transferred to them. Motion made by Williams, seconded by Dare, to allow the transfer. Williams yea, Dare yea, Schaefer yea. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Another reminder regarding Issue 2 money: no projects at this time.
- Gum Grove Rd. is only 15' wide. Roads Supervisor would like to use new firm (The Edge) on a contract basis to add 18" to each side of the road. Motion made by Williams, seconded by Dare, to have the road widened. Williams yea, Dare yea, Schaefer yea. Motion carried.
- Property at corner of Ward-Koebel Rd. and Rt. 350 cannot be purchased before it is officially listed for sale.

There being no further business, Williams made motion to adjourn, seconded by Dare, and meeting adjourned at 8:46pm.
