

Record of Proceedings - April 28, 2008

Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Schaefer, Dare, and Williams present. President Schaefer called the meeting to order. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$5234.23 were reported and filed for audit. Warrants 7496 thru 7510 totaling \$7513.98 were reviewed and signed.

There were no issues of discussion from the floor.

Our Roads Supervisor, Liston Burton, gave his report on the roads. He spoke with Kenny Walker, but is unable to get a price as yet due to rising fuel costs. Truck is in shop for a few repairs. Liston will order some culvert pipe. He mowed the Olive Branch Cemetery this week.

OLD BUSINESS:

Woods of Middleboro (Section 1) review with the county was cancelled until further notice.

NEW BUSINESS:

Regarding permanent storage of historical records, Fiscal Officer will inventory them and call Warren County Historical Society to see if they are interested in them. If not, she will contact the Ohio Historical Society.

May 1st is National Day of Prayer to be celebrated with a breakfast at Otterbein.

Purchase of business cards for all was discussed. 250 cards are free from VistaPrint.com (with minimal shipping). Fiscal Officer will order.

When the website is up and running smoothly, Karen will place ads in the Western Star to inform our citizens that we now have a website. Approved minutes and elected official contact info will be listed.
