

## **Record of Proceedings – July 28, 2008**

### **Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio**

The regular meeting was held with Williams, Dare and Schaefer present. President Schaefer called the meeting to order. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$14,172.87 were reported and filed for audit. Warrants 7575 thru 7593 totaling \$193,038.96 were reviewed and signed.

#### FROM THE FLOOR:

No concerns at this time.

#### ROADS REPORT:

Our Roads Supervisor, Liston Burton, gave his report on the roads.

- Crack-sealing is done and machine has been returned.
- Blacktopping was finished July 24<sup>th</sup>. Good job by Trampler Brothers; berms were hand-tamped and should hold up well. Thanks to Liston for his excellent oversight on the contract.
- Complaint about mailboxes being too low after adding blacktop; they must be raised by property owners.
- Employee from Turtlecreek Township behaved unprofessionally to Liston and contractors last week; we will notify their Trustees so that they are aware.
- Need to order more LOW SHOULDER signs.

#### OLD BUSINESS:

- Senior Road drainage should be improved with replacement of culvert.
- Woods at Middleboro inspection on July 22<sup>nd</sup> went well with a few exceptions; township may receive road soon.
- Thanks from Denny for condolences in loss of his mother last week.

#### NEW BUSINESS:

- Two zoning violations were reviewed.
- Liston had a helper drive truck while he was crack-sealing. Asked if he could be reimbursed for his time. Trustees agreed to reimburse helper \$12/hour, and also for any future needs that Liston might have. Williams yea, Dare yea, Schaefer yea.
- Liston will check on window replacement costs for the township hall. Will keep hall better sealed.

There being no further business, Williams made motion to adjourn, seconded by Dare, and meeting adjourned at 8:30pm.
