# Record of Proceedings – August 11, 2008 Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Williams, Dare and Schaefer present. President Schaefer called the meeting to order. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$5149.33 were reported and filed for audit. Warrants 7594 thru 7603 totaling \$4401.78 were reviewed and signed.

## FROM THE FLOOR:

Bonnie Mercuri, 9371 Strout Road, Clarksville wished to let the Trustees know of her plans to re-open her business (Bonnybrook Farms, previously in Centerville) here in Washington Township. They have built a horse barn, and a farm market building is underway. They will offer a place for school field trips, conferences, and for the general public to buy produce. They are applying for rezoning of a small portion of their land due to the fact that they wish to offer food service in their farm market building, which requires a commercial license.

# **ROADS REPORT:**

Our Roads Supervisor, Liston Burton, gave his report on the roads.

- Will most likely begin widening of Gum Grove Road next week, weather permitting. He will notify residents before-hand.
- Road signs have been received and are being installed.

- We need a township personnel policy regarding benefits for full-time employees. Fiscal Officer
  will present a draft based on the Ohio Township Sourcebook at the next meeting for the Trustees'
  review.
