

# **Record of Proceedings – January 26, 2009**

## **Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio**

The regular meeting was held with Schaefer, Williams and Dare present. President Dare called the meeting to order. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$6949.61 were reported and filed for audit. Warrants 7749 thru 7765 totaling \$19,285.55 were reviewed and signed.

### **FROM THE FLOOR:**

- Susan Case and Sabrina Poppe, representing the Warren County Equine Advisory Board, gave a presentation regarding their efforts to organize a network of trails and an equine center in the county. Ohio ranks 6th in the states in number of horses owned, and the owners have a large financial impact on the economy. The Equine Advisory Board undertook a census of horses in the county, and counted over 6000, with over 400 in Washington Township alone. They are working with the county extension office and their concerns have been included by the Warren County Regional Planning Commission in their 20-year long-range planning.
- Dave Korengel addressed further questions regarding the possible KOA campground to be built in the township. He stressed that not all effluvia would go to the underground holding tanks, but that the EPA requires mound systems for the bathhouses, and a pre-treatment system with leach lines. Also, any lines would be at least 100 feet from any property line. Concern was also raised that the campground has a fence line of sorts to keep campers from wandering onto private property.

### **ROADS REPORT:**

Our Roads Supervisor, Liston Burton, gave his report.

Due to the icy and snowy weather, Liston has been very busy on the roads. He would like to attend some further training classes in the near future, and the trustees heartily agreed that this would be worthwhile.

### **UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

Arabian Run Snow Removal Policy received and witnessed by the Trustees.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- Conservation Breakfast on February 21<sup>st</sup> at 9am for all Trustees.
- Boundary and Annexation Survey needs to be reviewed and returned. Roads Supervisor will complete.
- Warren County Township Association will hold training for the Drug Consortium for Trustees and Fiscal Officers on February 28<sup>th</sup> at 9am at the Hamilton Township Administration building. CDL drivers will have their meeting on Thursday, March 5<sup>th</sup> at 1pm. Cost of belonging to the consortium is \$350 per year.

There being no further business, Williams made motion to adjourn, seconded by Schaefer, and meeting adjourned at 7:52pm.
