

Record of Proceedings – April 13, 2009

Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Dare, Williams and Schaefer present. President Dare called the meeting to order. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$117,597.40 were reported and filed for audit. Warrants 7824 thru 7836 totaling \$13,906.43 were reviewed and signed.

FROM THE FLOOR:

Residents from Blazing Trail attended and expressed their frustration over the fact that the builder of Hopewell Meadows has not completed his obligations regarding the drainage and roadway on the back part of Arrowcreek and Blazing Trail. Until this is completed, this section will not be turned over for township maintenance. Warren County Engineer holds a performance bond. Trustees will send the County Engineer a letter with a copy to the Prosecutor's Office, asking for action. Residents may canvas their neighbors and send a petition/letter to the Engineer also.

ROADS REPORT:

Our Roads Supervisor, Liston Burton, is performing normal spring duties.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- Wilmington Road was cleared of litter the day after our last meeting.
