

Record of Proceedings – May 25, 2009

Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Dare and Schaefer present. President Dare called the meeting to order. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$21,286.48 were reported and filed for audit. Warrants 7858 thru 7874 totaling \$10,813.55 were reviewed and signed.

FROM THE FLOOR:

Nothing at this time.

ROADS REPORT:

- Our Roads Supervisor, Liston Burton, has begun mowing ditches.
- The cemetery on Gum Grove Road has been neglected by the Union Church and is in need of mowing. Liston had been told last year that the person with the records for the cemetery had taken them and moved to Florida. We will contact the Prosecutor's Office to see if they can determine how to contact someone who has responsibility for the cemetery.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Pursuant to the meeting on May 11th, the Prosecutor's Office replied that they have instructed the Engineer's Office to begin pulling bonds for unfinished work in the Hopewell Meadows subdivision.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Shepherd's Way is another road in the township that has not yet been turned over to us, and that needs work before it can be. The Warren County Engineer's Office is also looking at this situation.
- Maynard and Stella Hagemeyer of Olive Branch United Methodist Church donated a 3'x5' flag and 30 small flags for township cemeteries. Thank-you letter was signed.
- Fiscal Officer will research whether we can use auto deposit for our payroll checks.

There being no further business, Schaefer made motion to adjourn, seconded by Dare, and meeting adjourned at 8:17pm.
