

Record of Proceedings – July 13, 2009

Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Dare, Williams and Schaefer present. President Dare called the meeting to order. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$8339.48 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 7897 thru 7910 totaling \$13,603.04 were reviewed and signed.

FROM THE FLOOR:

- A resident expressed concern over speeding in the neighborhood and actions of a neighbor who has been shooting game in his backyard in close proximity to other homes. He has shot rabbits and squirrels and the resident is worried about children possibly being hurt. He was advised to speak to the neighbor and let him know of his concerns. The Game Warden could be called in if he witnesses this again, as he may be taking animals out of season. The neighbors could also report the incident to the County Sheriff if they feel he is shooting in an unsafe manner.
- Clinton-Warren Joint Fire District representatives are going door-to-door selling coupons for portrait sittings in order to raise funds for a new defibrillator. Williams reported that this is legitimate.

ROADS REPORT:

Report from our Roads Supervisor, Liston Burton:

- Crack sealer has not yet arrived.
- Liston has been berming throughout the township.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- Burton, Dare and Williams will attend the meeting with the County Commissioners July 14 regarding the three builders in the township who have defaulted on their responsibilities.
- Zoning violations were discussed.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Proposed budget for 2010 was presented by the Fiscal Officer. Williams made motion to accept, Schaefer seconded. Motion carried. Budget will be turned in to the County Auditor by July 20.
- Route 123 into Lebanon will be closed for approximately 30 days for repair. Can detour on Liberty-Keuter to Wilmington Road.
- Connect Ohio is a public-private partnership between the state of Ohio and Connected Nation, a national non-profit organization. Their goal is to extend broadband coverage to the state's unserved areas. Residents may visit their website, www.connectohio.org and complete a form online to let them know that you do not have high-speed internet available at your home.

There being no further business, Schaefer made motion to adjourn, seconded by Williams, and meeting adjourned at 8:37pm.
