

Record of Proceedings – September 28, 2009

Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Dare, Williams and Schaefer present. President Dare called the meeting to order. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$109,790.88 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 7962 thru 7974 totaling \$13,737.26 were reviewed and signed.

FROM THE FLOOR:

ROADS REPORT:

Report from our Roads Supervisor, Liston Burton:

- County Engineer's office will review Blue Shin Hill with Liston to see if nailings in the hill would be beneficial
- Liston has been berming throughout the township
- Will install security system this week
- Approximately 85 tons salt on hand as well as approximately 70 tons mixed 1:1 with grits. With salt committed from Morton Salt, we should be fine for this winter.
- Light by Oregonia post office still out; Liston has reported.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- Break-ins of private homes and outbuildings are continuing in the area.
- Concerns were expressed over anticipated high traffic on Fischer and Strout Roads on weekends due to Bonnybrook Farms. Liston will monitor.
- Minister has hired someone to occasionally mow the Union Cemetery on Gum Grove Road.
- Tombstone Restoration Clinic has been postponed until spring. Contact is Vicki Bergerhouse at 513-695-1144.

Second half property tax has been received and deposited.
