

Record of Proceedings – October 12, 2009

Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Dare, Williams and Schaefer present. President Dare called the meeting to order. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$5,759.98 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 7975 thru 7981 totaling \$4,534.41 were reviewed and signed.

FROM THE FLOOR:

Nothing at this time.

ROADS REPORT:

No report from our Roads Supervisor, Liston Burton at this time.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- Dare spoke with representative of Duke Energy regarding the streetlight near the Oregonia post office. He was advised that it may be 10-15 working days until it is repaired.
- Warren County Prosecutor's Office has filed suit against Trailblazer Homes (builder of Hopewell Meadows) and Villa Mortgage (the bond holder) for money owed to complete the subdivision's roads and for money owed to the township for snow clearing.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Warren County Engineer's Office has offered to sell the township salt at \$70 per ton if needed. Motion made by Williams, seconded by Schaefer, to sign up for 100 tons just in case. Schaefer yea, Williams yea, Dare yea. Motion carried.
- An email was received complaining of large amount of bicycles on the road. The bikes have a right to be on the road, and the sheriff's office is generally engaged to monitor the race. Any complaints should be directed to the sheriff's office.
- Residents are warned to be aware of check scams asking for money up front in order to cash a check.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned at 8:17pm.
