The regular meeting was held with Dare, Williams and Schaefer present. President Dare called the meeting to order. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$15,972.40 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 7982 thru 7988 totaling \$20,394.14 were reviewed and signed.
