

Record of Proceedings – January 25, 2010

Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Hagemeyer, Schaefer and Williams present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. President Williams called the meeting to order. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$6,926.48 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 8054 thru 8075 totaling \$29,904.98 were presented for approval. Schaefer made motion to pay bills, seconded by Hagemeyer. Vote was Hagemeyer yea, Schaefer yea, Williams yea.

FROM THE FLOOR:

Schaefer and Hagemeyer spoke with the Sheriff's office and with the Engineer's office regarding speeding in the township, specifically on Ward-Koebel Road. Patrols will be increased in the hope of catching speeders; it was also advised to note down make of car and license plate number if possible. An engineering study could be requested. Liston will put up signs in an effort to slow folks down.

ROADS REPORT:

- Plenty of salt on hand; some potholes appearing.
- Might be some setback issues for church's parking lot on corner.
- Dead batteries in old truck may have been due to malfunctioning dome light.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- Hagemeyer will be added to the list of drivers for the township in the event of an emergency.
- The Warren County Genealogical Society is offering a Cemetery Restoration Clinic on April 10 at Crossman Cemetery in Pleasant Plain; cost is \$35 to attend. Hagemeyer and Burton would like to attend. Schaefer made motion to cover the fee, seconded by Hagemeyer. Vote was Hagemeyer yea, Schaefer yea, Williams yea.
- Township received a plaque from Silver Grove Baptist Church in appreciation of their cooperation in rebuilding their church.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Zoning violation on Route 350
- iFiber in Middletown is expanding internet connectivity into Clarksville
- January Warren County Regional Planning Commission was cancelled; Hagemeyer will attend the next one on April 13th at 7pm
- Special Election will be held only at Township Hall on February 2nd
- Warren County Drug Task Force requested support in 2010 in the amount of \$1000; Schaefer made motion to do so, seconded by Hagemeyer. Vote was Hagemeyer yea, Schaefer yea, Williams yea.
