

Record of Proceedings – March 8, 2010

Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Hagemeyer, Schaefer and Williams present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. President Williams called the meeting to order. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$6,240.46 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 8103 thru 8111 totaling \$6,354.77 were presented for approval.

FROM THE FLOOR:

Our next meeting will begin at 8pm due to Daylight Savings Time.

ROADS REPORT:

From our Roads Supervisor, Liston Burton:

- Old truck will need a bit of renovation this spring: new bottom for bed, replace diesel and oil lines
- Roads are holding up fairly well; will evaluate them in about a month as the weather warms up as far as summer projects are concerned
- Will rent the BrewPro hot crack sealing machine this summer for a couple weeks

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- Discussion between iFiber and Warren County Economic Development Department continuing; no problems are anticipated. It is hoped that a large part of the township could receive broadband when this project is finished
- Warren County Engineer's Office sent email regarding CountryTyme development Woods of Middleboro. He does not anticipate problems getting this subdivision finished this summer. Prosecutor is working on recovering funds from Trailblazer Homes for Hopewell Meadows. Spring Haven subdivision's bond is not adequate to finish.
- Fiscal Officer researched investment options for the township. We are limited as funds must be FDIC insured. Schaefer made motion to keep our investment in a CD at LCNB, seconded by Hagemeyer. Hagemeyer yea, Schaefer yea, Williams yea. Motion carried.
- Williams attended Warren County Health Department meeting on March 2; all is going well. The Health Board provides many services to the citizens.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Warren County Regional Planning Commission Executive Committee met on February 25 to discuss reevaluation of Subdivision Regulations. There was much discussion and topics were tabled until a future meeting that will be announced.
- Warren County Board of Elections will use the Township Hall on May 4 for a primary election.
- Thank-you received from Clarksville mail carrier for our excellent road upkeep this winter
- Warren County zoning violation reported
- Home on Ward-Koebel Road being cleaned up and yard will hopefully not be a problem this year
- Boundary Validation Program request received; Trustees are asked to review files of our township boundaries and acknowledge if they are correct.
