

Record of Proceedings – April 26, 2010

Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Hagemeyer, Schaefer and Williams present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and President Williams called the meeting to order. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$113,548.01 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 8140 thru 8155 totaling \$14,757.60 were presented for approval.

FROM THE FLOOR:

- A couple residents reported that they had not received a census form in the mail and were told that they are available at the public libraries.
- Lt. Eric Johnson in attendance; he will again pursue topic of bike race protocol with Sheriff's Office. Speeding on Ward-Koebel was again mentioned.

ROADS REPORT:

From our Roads Supervisor, Liston Burton:

- Load of cold patch received
- Unaccepted roads still a problem; county is working on getting dollars to finish work.
- Liston proposes small blacktop jobs this year, including a few culverts. Motion made by Schaefer, seconded by Hagemeyer to support this endeavor. Motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- iFiber has paperwork in place to use the county tower near I-71; owner is getting start-up dollars ready.
- Snow billing sent out April 14th via regular mail to builders of unaccepted subdivisions; Fornshell Homes was returned. Fiscal Officer will send out others certified.
- Bike race was held in township last week; no permit was on file. Problem with the riders spread out all over both sides of the road.
- Hagemeyer would like to obtain supplies to begin restoration of headstones at the Olive Branch Cemetery, and suggested \$400 for cement and brushes. He mentioned that he can find volunteers to assist with the restoration of headstones. Burton mentioned that he can donate concrete culvert pipe to help with the crossing, but we would need to pour concrete over top. Williams wishes to ask Olive Branch United Methodist Church Council if they could help with the project financially. Schaefer will bring the subject up at the next meeting of the church council in June.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Warren County Township Association will hold a family picnic on July 31st at 4pm at Armco Park for all township and county elected officials and employees. Hog will be donated; bring a side dish.
- There will be a public hearing on the proposed changes to the Subdivision Regulations at the County Commissioners Room on May 18 at 9:30am.
- Warren County Prayer Breakfast will be held May 6th at 7am at the administration building.
- Warren County Drug Task Force conducted a search on SR 350 on April 15. Meth was found and seized.
- Fiscal Officer reported that first half of property taxes have been received in the amount of \$102,715.86.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned at 8:53pm.
