

Record of Proceedings – June 14, 2010

Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Hagemeyer, Schaefer and Williams present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and President Williams called the meeting to order. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$22,502.83 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 8176 thru 8181 totaling \$1,013.28 were presented for approval.

FROM THE FLOOR:

- Susan Case presented Warren County Foundation grant application if the township wishes to pursue grant money to help with Olive Branch Cemetery restoration
- Speeding on Ward-Koebel still an issue, especially 4-wheelers
- Resident on Ward-Koebel may want culvert replaced; he was informed that if he buys the culvert, our Roads Supervisor will install.

ROADS REPORT:

From our Roads Supervisor, Liston Burton:

Bonnybrook Farms has begun installing lane out onto Route 132.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- Liston collecting materials for Olive Branch Cemetery restoration project
- Union Cemetery on Gum Grove, a privately-owned cemetery, was mowed and trimmed by volunteers before Memorial Day. Thanks to all who participated.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Some road edges on Strout are breaking down on Blue Shin hill. Liston will dig out and berm with cold patch
- Little River Café in Oregonia may be re-opening soon
- Fire Board met last Thursday; some runs are becoming hard to staff
- We will need to place our two fire levies for 1.0 and 1.06 mills on the November ballot for renewal. Motion made by Schaefer, seconded by Hagemeyer, to send Resolutions 2010-0614A and 2010-0614B to the Warren County Auditor, asking for certification of values that would be generated by this renewal. Motion carried.
- Warren County Township Association met on June 12; representatives from the Center for Public Management of Regional Affairs were present and urged participation in local government wage survey that will be forthcoming.
- Unmowed yard at 8053 Strout Road is a nuisance; Ohio Revised Code 505.87 dictates that we notify owner by certified letter. Fiscal Officer will do so.
- Warning from the Ohio Attorney General received of scams targeting those on public assistance. The public is warned not to share personal information with callers.
- Prescription drug drop-off will be held June 19 at Bethesda Arrow Springs Hospital from 9-12:30. Remove labels.
- Our membership in the Cooperative Purchasing Program of Department of Administrative Services has expired; Karen will make sure there is no fee to re-instate when we wish to re-join. If not, we will let this \$100 yearly membership lapse as we don't need to make any large purchases this year.
- Our Roads Supervisor will plan next year's proposed projects and expenditures, and present them at the June 28th meeting. The Fiscal Officer will then present a proposed budget for 2011 at our July 12th meeting.
