

Record of Proceedings – August 23, 2010

Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Hagemeyer, Schaefer and Williams present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and President Williams called the meeting to order. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$4300.02 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 8238 thru 8256 totaling \$10,541.26 were presented for approval.

FROM THE FLOOR:

- Deputy Eric Johnson attended and was available for questions
- A resident asked if he could legally be on the road with his tractor pulling 10 foot bush hog as long as he had a Slow Moving Equipment sign. He was informed that it is ok as long as he can give up half the road when oncoming traffic is present.

ROADS REPORT:

From our Roads Supervisor, Liston Burton:

- County may make temporary repair on Arrowcreek Drive if possible
- Liston presented truck proposals through the state purchasing program. The best price was an F550 diesel through Beau Townsend of Vandalia. Schaefer made motion, seconded by Hagemeyer, to proceed with the purchase. Motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- Resolution 2010-0823 was presented to certify mowing costs to the County Auditor. Schaefer made motion to proceed, seconded by Hagemeyer. Motion carried.
- Hagemeyer and Burton will soon begin volunteer work at Olive Branch Cemetery restoring headstones
- Wayne Fire Contract will be discussed soon; Hagemeyer will send them a copy of some topics of discussion
- Tax Budget meeting will take place on August 31 at 1:45pm in the Commissioner's Meeting Room
