

Record of Proceedings – September 27, 2010

Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Hagemeyer, Schaefer and Williams present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and President Williams called the meeting to order. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$104,317.71 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 8267 thru 8282 totaling \$18,200.40 were presented for approval.

FROM THE FLOOR:

- Justin Rich, a Boy Scout, is looking to earn his Citizenship in Community badge as an Eagle Scout project. This project should take 40-80 hours. It was suggested that he help with Olive Branch Cemetery restoration project, under the direction of the Trustees. He and his father will meet with Hagemeyer at the cemetery to discuss possibilities.
- Deputy Eric Johnson attended and will bring report of first half 2010 sheriff's activities to the next meeting.

ROADS REPORT:

From our Roads Supervisor, Liston Burton:

- Truck being built; will be delivered in November
- Roads swept of excess gravel after chip sealing
- Liston will be on vacation this week

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- Temporary fix on Arrowcreek Drive over creek is complete and plate is gone.
- The Washington Township Fire/EMS Support Levy Committee will be placing signs around the township in support of the two upcoming levies, which will partially reimburse the township for services provided to its residents by the Salem-Morrow and Wayne Fire Departments. There will be no increase in taxes.
- Warren County Foundation has awarded \$550 to Washington Township Trustees to help with Olive Branch Cemetery restoration project.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Local resident complained of condition of Ward-Koebel Rd as it had much loose gravel and dust. It was explained that the loose gravel had since been swept, and that the road would be in great condition as soon as it rains.
- We received our second half property tax settlement from the county in the amount of \$91,947; last year's second half distribution was \$96,890.
