

Record of Proceedings – November 8, 2010

Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Hagemeyer, Schaefer and Williams present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and President Williams called the meeting to order. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$22,080.96 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 8303 thru 8311 totaling \$15,393.72 were presented for approval.

FROM THE FLOOR:

Resident inquired about the status of acquiring high-speed internet in the township. One resident reported that Frontier (local service provider) says it is too expensive, and they will not install high-speed in the near future. Some use a Verizon or Sprint card that works well for about \$60/month, and is fairly fast. With improvements in technology, other alternatives may soon be available.

ROADS REPORT:

From our Roads Supervisor, Liston Burton:

- New truck is at K.E. Rose getting finishing touches.
- Landmark wants our fuel tank to be double-walled. Liston will price a 500 gallon double-walled tank.
- Backhoe may need new battery.
- New slide area in center of Blue Shin Hill, below the curve. Liston will fill with tar for now. He feels it is due to the extreme dry weather.
- Area on Shawhan-Ayres is washed-out. Liston will fill approximately 175 foot length with concrete chunks.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- On the bike race topic, representatives from the Sheriff's and Prosecutor's offices will try to attend our next meeting to discuss problems with clean-up after races.
- Warren County Township Association Fall Dinner is coming up on November 12th; Hagemeyer and Schaefer will attend. Fiscal Officer will cut warrant and include annual dues.
