

Record of Proceedings – March 28, 2011

Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Williams, Hagemeyer and Schaefer present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and President Schaefer called the meeting to order. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$6,227.53 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 8430 thru 8449 and Voucher 3 totaling \$27,364.50 were presented for approval.

FROM THE FLOOR:

Warren County Prosecutor David Fornshell introduced himself to the Trustees and the public in attendance. He grew up here locally, and is looking forward to serving the county. Prior to his current position, he worked in a law firm in Cincinnati for 12 years and also served as Assistant Prosecutor to the City of Blue Ash for eight years. He is committed to providing excellent service according to our needs. Gary Loxley is still our contact for township questions, but Mr. Fornshell encourages the Trustees to keep him in the loop as he comes up to speed and gets to know about our needs and concerns. Bruce McGary will still work as Assistant Prosecutor for the county, and could also be contacted if Gary is unavailable.

ROADS REPORT:

From our Roads Supervisor, Liston Burton:

- Stream that runs next to Olive Branch Cemetery has been a dumping place for many deer carcasses. Liston will contact the county health department to pursue a solution
- Hoop building parts received; will be installing it soon
- Will rent BrewPro machine for two weeks this summer as sealing cracks in the roads has been a good stop-gap measure against deterioration
- Township is in good shape regarding culverts; may have to replace only five or so
- Chip and Seal will be discussed at the next meeting.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Mike Yetter and others of Zoning will meet with the Trustees soon regarding the proposed changes to the Warren County Rural Zoning Code

NEW BUSINESS:

- Jeffery Road will be closed between Ross and Olive Branch Roads on Saturday, April 2 from 8am-8pm due to a fire department exercise

- Our representative to the Warren County Regional Planning Commission for 2011 will be Scott Hagemeyer; alternate is Paul Schaefer.
