

Record of Proceedings – April 25, 2011

Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Hagemeyer and Schaefer present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and President Schaefer called the meeting to order. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$7,201.13 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 8454 thru 8468 totaling \$17,725.13 were presented for approval.

FROM THE FLOOR:

Nothing at this time.

ROADS REPORT:

From our Roads Supervisor, Liston Burton:

- Strout Road developed a slide on April 25 due to huge rains. Jim Clark is working on an estimate for backhoe work; will need much rip-rap stone to save the road base. Liston estimates \$15,000 for the whole project. Fiscal Officer will open a blanket purchase order to cover these expenses.
- We will re-bill the developer for Arabian Run snow plowing/salt expenses from the winter of 2009-2010. The invoiced bill of \$4800 has not yet been paid.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- Liston has many pavers that he can donate to the township for the Olive Branch Cemetery repair – will not be necessary to buy any. Proposal is to build up two long beds to house the displaced headstones alphabetically
- State of Ohio House Bill 5 will tighten our budget to some extent. The website www.sb5truth.com offers facts about the bill; especially helpful is the “Myth versus Reality” section
- Hagemeyer attended April 12 Warren County Regional Planning Commission meeting; main topic was the proposed Rural Zoning Code re-write. There is a new map that shows some three acre density areas

NEW BUSINESS:

- Annual Open House at the First Black School in Harveysburg will be May 15 from 1-5pm
- Hagemeyer is scheduled to attend the Public Records class on June 15
- Warren County Historical Society is offering “Tales from the Golden Lamb” luncheon May 18 at 11:30am
- Warren County National Day of Prayer will be May 5th at 7am at Heritage Baptist Church in Lebanon; reservations required
