

Record of Proceedings – July 25, 2011

Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Williams, Hagemeyer and Schaefer present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and President Schaefer called the meeting to order. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$4,155.65 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 8515 thru 8530 and Voucher 7 totaling \$13,242.18 were presented for approval.

FROM THE FLOOR:

ROADS REPORT:

From our Roads Supervisor, Liston Burton:

- Crack sealing went well – machine returned.
- New computer installed in truck – under warranty
- Trampler agreed to use large vibratory roller
- Too hot for blacktopping right now.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Fiscal Officer presented Permanent Appropriation Resolution to the Board. Williams made motion to accept, seconded by Hagemeyer. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Complaints received regarding tall grass/weeds at 1055 Middleboro Road, and 10793 Wilmington Road was also mentioned. Williams made motion to begin the process to declare these properties a nuisance and Hagemeyer seconded. Motion carried. Fiscal Officer will post a letter on the doors and take pictures.
- Director of Camp Joy is having issues with a neighbor crossing his property to reach some landlocked property. He wishes to keep an amicable relationship, and wondered what his options are. Hagemeyer will call to discuss.
- Line fence question from resident at 933 Ward-Koebel; Trustees would like resident to attend our next meeting to discuss, as this issue can be intricate.
- Representative from Channel 2 in Dayton will be at the Warren County government offices on August 17 at 9am to discuss the fact that our northern Warren County area is lumped into the Cincinnati market, and shut out of the Dayton market. Trustees are invited to attend.
