

Record of Proceedings – October 24, 2011

Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Williams, Hagemeyer and Schaefer present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and President Schaefer called the meeting to order. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$18,621.12 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 8590 thru 8605 totaling \$7,377.01 plus Voucher 10 were presented for approval.

FROM THE FLOOR:

Nothing at this time.

ROADS REPORT:

From our Roads Supervisor, Liston Burton:

- Has been preparing equipment for winter
- Roads are now swept of grit from summer projects

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- Hagemeyer made motion, seconded by Williams, to adopt Resolution 2011-1024 to certify snow and ice removal costs on unaccepted streets in the township to the county auditor for placement on the tax duplicate. Resolution was adopted.
- Trustees are very concerned about condition of unaccepted streets as blacktop is deteriorating. We will forge ahead with a letter to the County Commissioners, with a copy to the Engineer's and Prosecutor's offices, and include pictures of broken-down areas. If these continue to break down, repairs will be much more difficult and expensive. Until these private streets are accepted by the township, they are the responsibility of the builder or county if builder fails to complete.
- Quarterly Warren County Regional Planning Commission meeting was held October 11; it was uneventful.
- Mr. Rich reports that work is complete at Olive Branch Cemetery (Eagle Scout project of his son). Hagemeyer will get names of scouts in troop so we can thank them, and he will also research signs. Re-dedication of the cemetery will take place on November 12 at 11 am. Karen will place this notice in the Sunday bulletin at Olive Branch United Methodist Church.

NEW BUSINESS:

Time will fall back before our next meeting; therefore our meeting on November 14 will be at 7pm.

There being no further business, Williams made motion at 8:32pm to adjourn, seconded by Hagemeyer. Motion carried.
