

Record of Proceedings – March 26, 2012

Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Williams and Schaefer present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and Vice-President Williams called the meeting to order. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$15,862.08 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 8715 thru 8731 and Voucher 15 totaling \$23,633.64 were presented for approval.

FROM THE FLOOR:

Warren County Prosecutor David Fornshell reported on his office's activity in 2011. In total, they were responsible for more than 22,070 court cases, including 880 felonies, 2546 juvenile cases, 6,644 adult misdemeanors and over 12,000 child support cases. In addition, they provided legal counsel to 30 county agencies, nine townships and five public libraries. The full report can be viewed at www.co.warren.oh.us/prosecutor. They worked hard in 2011 to stay under budget, and are continuing to cut costs whenever possible.

ROADS REPORT:

From our Roads Supervisor, Liston Burton:

- They have been marking culverts to be cut out
- Will begin mowing
- Getting equipment ready for spring.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

The request from a resident to vacate Fischer Road is still awaiting survey results. Williams made motion to table the topic until we hear back from the county engineer's office, seconded by Schaefer. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Trustees urged Roads' employees to take a look at Wilkerson-Vandervoort Cemetery to see what maintenance it might need. Some of the headstones may need to be repaired.
- Received a request from the Warren County Commissioners to support them in petitioning that US Route 42 within the county to be designated as "Warren County Veterans' Highway". Schaefer made motion, seconded by Williams, to support this request. Motion carried. We will send them a supporting resolution at the next meeting.
- On May 22 from 6-8pm, there will be an Emergency Readiness meeting at the Hamilton Township Building; Hagemeyer will attend on behalf of the Trustees.
- Schaefer made motion, seconded by Williams, to make our 2012 Temporary Appropriations permanent. Motion carried.
- Fiscal Officer Doney's first term in office ends March 31, and Williams issued the Oath of Office for her second term.

As there was no further business, Schaefer made motion, seconded by Williams, to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:40pm.
