

Record of Proceedings – November 25, 2013 Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The regular meeting was held with Williams, Schaefer and Hagemeyer present. President Williams opened the meeting, and all recited the Pledge of Allegiance. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$6,631.85 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 9274 through 9284 and Voucher 34-2013 totaling \$7400.87 were presented for approval.

FROM THE FLOOR:

Scott Rich has asked to contract to the township on an as-needed basis to help with plowing the roads. He has much experience in this area, and he was given a Contractor's packet to fill out.

ROADS REPORT:

From our Roads Supervisor, Allen Stanforth:

- A deputy called Allen and reported that a resident on State Route 350 reported that she has a grave on her property. It is not officially identified with the county. Hagemeyer will advise her to speak to the county prosecutor.
- Bridge at end of Strout is now limited to 20 tons. Contact Roy Henson at the county with questions.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Citizens' lawsuit against the truck stop project at Route 123 and I-71 has failed, and the project will continue.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Hagemeyer received a call from an anonymous resident regarding a trash problem on Middleboro Rd. He called the Zoning Department to handle.
- Our contact for the CDL Consortium has changed.
- The Warren County Regional Planning Commission offers a comprehensive plan for the township if we wish to pursue. One was done in the past. Trustees may consider in the future.

As there was no further business, Schaefer made motion, seconded by Hagemeyer, to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:24pm.
