

## **Record of Proceedings – December 10, 2012**

### **Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio**

The regular meeting was held with Schaefer, Williams and Hagemeyer present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and President Hagemeyer called the meeting to order. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Receipts of \$16,731.82 since our last meeting were reported and were filed for audit. Warrants 8937 through 8961 totaling \$15,507.10 were presented for approval.

#### **FROM THE FLOOR:**

- A resident had a question about the Beatty Farm property on Route 132 – Trustees were not aware of answer, and encouraged her to check on the Auditor’s website.
- She also wondered if the township has a disaster plan in place. She was informed that all counties have an Emergency Management System at the county level.

#### **ROADS REPORT:**

From our Roads Supervisor, Allen Stanforth:

- The International 4900 truck and Meyer snow plow sold at auction; proceeds were \$5602.50
- Allen met with Sheila Withrow today regarding our township’s road mileage
- Arabian Run blacktop is complete; the builder’s bond covered the costs. Allen has asked the county to correct some major ditching issues, while he will take care of some small problems.
- Allen would like to hire a helper for a short time to help with trimming trees. This is a safety issue to have someone else along while using the bucket truck. Contractor will fill out the appropriate Contractor forms and will be paid at \$12 per hour.
- Shaver HD12 post driver was \$7200 new. We will be selling soon.

#### **UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

- Regarding bike races – there is no state law that requires organizers to obtain a permit for races. Warren County Rural Zoning code would have to be amended. This question arose in reference to a bill we received from Wayne Township Fire Department this year after they responded to an accident of two bikers.
- This will be the last meeting of the year as the second meeting would fall on Christmas Eve.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- Resident asked the Trustees about having the Clinton-Warren Joint Fire District burn down an old home as an exercise. It is technically in the service area of Wayne Township Fire Department; Scott will advise.
- Williams noted that a break in ditch on Gum Grove Road is eroding towards our roadway. Stanforth will investigate.

As there was no further business, Schaefer made motion, seconded by Williams, to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:38pm.
