

Record of Proceedings – June 22, 2020
Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 PM by President Schaefer, with Fisher, and Hagemeyer present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The minutes of the May 25, 2020 and June 17, 2020 “Special Meeting” were mailed to the Trustees prior to the meeting for review. Warrants 11073 through 11104 totaling \$41,533.52 were presented for approval.

Mr. Hagemeyer made a motion, seconded by Mr. Fisher to approve the minutes for both the May 25, 2020 and the June 17, 2020 “Special Meeting”.

Vote – Schaefer, aye; Hagemeyer, aye; Fisher, aye. Motion passed.

Mr. Hagemeyer made a motion, seconded by Mr. Fisher to approve the bills.

Vote – Schaefer, aye; Hagemeyer, aye; Fisher, aye. Motion passed.

FROM THE FLOOR: A resident asked about the “Special Meeting” held on June 17, 2020. Mr. Schaefer stated that Don Tharr and Dean Tharr attended and discussed with the Trustees the damage that was accidentally done by Mr. Tharr’s tractor on Arrowcreek Drive in Blazing Trail. The damage totaled \$30,600.00. Mr. Tharr will turn the claim in to his insurance company.

Trustees would like to have the damage repaired by the end of July.

A motion was made by Mr. Fisher and seconded by Mr. Hagemeyer to go ahead and begin the process to get Arrowcreek Drive, Blazing Trail fixed. Allen will contact Barrett Paving and schedule the repair. The Township will pay the bill and then be reimbursed by Mr. Tharr. If the Township is not reimbursed, legal action can be taken.

Vote – Schaefer, aye; Hagemeyer, aye; Fisher, aye. Motion passed.

Ms. Coffman will contact Adam Nice from the Warren County Prosecutor’s Office and ask him to prepare the paperwork.

Mr. Schaefer suggested we return to two meetings per month since a lot is going on. All agreed.

The Public Hearing to discuss the 2021 Budget was opened at 8:12 PM. Trustees reviewed the budget. A vote will be taken at the next regular meeting. Hearing closed at 8:30 PM.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Mr. Schaefer reported that the Kings Domain Rehabilitation Center was approved at the BZA hearing and is projected to be open in 2022.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mr. Fisher stated that the Arabian Run paving looks much better. A couple of issues have come up about equipment being parked on the road and logs stored along the road. Mr. Stanforth said the only issue he has had is with plowing. Mr. Stanforth will visit the residence and see if the problem can be solved without further action.

Mr. Fisher stated that Michelle Tegtmeier informed him that complaints have been coming in concerning Little River Bar and Grill noise, crowds, and late hours.

Mr. Schaefer presented a notice from the Ohio Division of Liquor Control asking if the Township would like to have a hearing on issuing a permit. The Trustees agreed that no hearing was needed. Ms. Coffman will mail the form back and state no hearing is needed.

Ms. Coffman presented Resolutions 06-2020-01 and 06-2020-02. Supplement to Annual Appropriation Resolution. A motion was made by Mr. Hagemeyer and seconded by Mr. Fisher to approve Resolution 06-2020-01 and 06-2020-02.

Vote – Schaefer, aye; Hagemeyer, aye; Fisher, aye. Motion passed.

As there was no further business, Mr. Hagemeyer made a motion, seconded by Mr. Fisher to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:51 PM.
