

Record of Proceedings – August 23, 2021
Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 PM by President Scott Hagemeyer, with Paul Schaefer and Jason Fisher present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The minutes of August 9, 2021 were mailed to the Trustees prior to the meeting for review. Warrants 11468 through 11487 totaling \$63,239.34 were presented for approval.

Mr. Schaefer made a motion, seconded by Mr. Fisher to approve the minutes for the August 9, 2021 regular meeting. Hagemeyer, aye; Fisher, aye; Schaefer, aye. Motion passed.

Present for the meeting were: Tim Books, and Dominic Brigano.

FROM THE FLOOR:

- Dominic Brigano stated that there is a Township Stimulus Program available that offers funding to townships for sidewalks, roadways, and culverts. He will send us the information.

ROADS REPORT:

- Allen and Todd have been working on Dura Patching for the past two weeks. One more Friday and they will be finished.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Mr. Hagemeyer stated that no complaints had been presented concerning the chip and seal projects.
- Mr. Hagemeyer stated that there have been no new complaints concerning Little River Bar and Grill.
- Ms. Coffman stated that the ARP funding request has been submitted and approved for \$161,054.76.
- A motion was made by Mr. Schaefer and seconded by Mr. Fisher to nominate Denver Williams as the Member At Large to the WCJFD. Hagemeyer, aye; Fisher, aye; Schaefer, aye. Motion passed.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Mr. Fisher reported that the new squad for WCJFD came in on August 12, 2021. All members will be trained on the new unit before it goes out for runs. They received the Legacy Grant for \$20,000.00. July to August, they had 73 EMS runs and 33 fire runs.
- Mr. Hagemeyer stated that on July 29, 2021 he and State Representative Scott Lipps visited Brausch Farms. Mr. Brausch was not available to be there but they spoke with him on the phone. He said that he was going to move some of the compost to a landfill, he also has some that has been screened,

approved, and is ready to be distributed, and that his attorney suggested that he continue doing as he has been doing until he no longer can.

- Ms. Coffman reported that Scott Mobray had emailed a complaint concerning 7582 Strout Road having trash and junk cars in the yard. She has sent the complaint information to the Warren County Rural Zoning Commission and was told that an inspector will be sent out as soon as possible.
- Mr. Schaefer will not be present at the September 13, 2021 meeting.

A motion was made by Mr. Schaefer and seconded by Mr. Fisher to adjourn at 8:23 PM.
