

Record of Proceedings – May 23, 2022
Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by President Jason Fisher with Mr. Schaefer and Mr. Hagemeyer present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The minutes of May 9 2022 were mailed to the Trustees prior to the meeting for review. Warrants 11682 through 11698 totaling \$9689.06 were presented for approval.

Mr. Hagemeyer made a motion, seconded by Mr. Schaefer to approve the minutes for the May 9, 2022 regular meeting. Fisher, aye; Schaefer, aye; Hagemeyer, aye. Motion passed.

FROM THE FLOOR: Don and Joyce Crim thanked the Trustees for cleaning up the property at 166 Clarksville Road by removing the abandoned "Junk" White Dodge Van. The Trustees wanted to thank Phipps Auto Parts for picking it up. They have done a great job.

ROADS REPORT:

- Mr. Stanforth stated he was finishing up the first round of mowing the roads this week.
- The new backhoe is working great.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Mr. Schaefer reported that the old pumper from the WCJFD has gone to Arkansas after being sold.
- Mr. Hagemeyer stated he had followed up on the discussion last week about campaign signs being left around the Township. No one from the Central Committee or the Warren County Board of Elections seem to have the authority to have those removed.
- Mr. Fisher reported that he has not had any updates on the Strout Road speed study as of yet.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Mr. Schaefer stated that he will be attending the May 25, 2022 Township Association meeting and the June 1st Western Water meeting.
- Mr. Hagemeyer said that there had been more noise complaints concerning Little River Bar and Grill and had expected that some citizens would attend this evenings meeting but no one did. Mr. Fisher will speak with Mr. Nice at the Warren County Prosecutor's Office and see how much impact the Township could have on their liquor license.

- Mr. Fisher stated that the Warren County Engineer's Office is posting new weight limits signs for the bridge on Oregonia Road north of the old one.
- The Warren County Rural Zoning Commission emailed a partial packet to the Trustees and Ms. Coffman about the Daniel & Leslie Moke Variance Request at 2142 Gum Grove Road. The applicant is requesting a variance for a 3' side yard set back in lieu of a 10 ft. for an existing building. The Trustees have no comment at this time but will review further once the entire package is received. The case will be heard by the Board of Zoning Appeals on June 22, 2022 at 6:30 PM.
