

Record of Proceedings – May 9, 2022
Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by President Jason Fisher with Mr. Schaefer and Mr. Hagemeyer present.

The minutes of April 25, 2022 were mailed to the Trustees prior to the meeting for review. Warrants 11676 through 11681 totaling \$4515.56 were presented for approval.

ROADS REPORT:

- Mr. Stanforth stated he checked all the culverts after the rain. Senior Road double culvert needs some work but all others look good.
- Mr. Stanforth reported that the high-water signs were stolen after placement on Ward Koebel Road at Arrowcreek Drive. He still has some that he can use for now.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Mr. Schaefer stated that the van at 166 Clarksville Road is gone. Mr. Hagemeyer said that he had presented the “Junk Affidavit” to Phipps Auto Parts, 10429 Cozzaddale-Murdock Road, Goshen Ohio 45122 after our last meeting.
- Mr. Fisher reported that someone has tried to clean up 7582 Strout Road after we sent the certified letter requesting they clean up the trash and garbage from the yard. Any further action will be halted at this time but the Trustees will keep an eye on it.
- Ms. Coffman reported that the 2007 backhoe sold on GovDeals for \$34,000.00 and is coordinating with the purchaser for them to pick up.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Mr. Schaefer reported the WCJFD sold the old pumper for \$30,000.00.
- Mr. Schaefer stated that some of the election signs are still posted around the Township. Mr. Hagemeyer has sent an email to Julie Burns the Warren County Republican Party Chair, asking her to send an email to Central Committee Members and Campaign Committees asking everyone to pick up

their signs. Mr. Hagemeyer will follow up and reach out to Lori Viars from the Warren County Board of Elections.

- Mr. Fisher stated that Wilmington Road will be closed for 3 days starting May 16, 2022.
- Warren County Soil & Water Conservation District is having a Pond Clinic on Thursday June 16, 2022 from 5:30 -8:00.
