

Record of Proceedings – June 27, 2022
Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by President Jason Fisher with Mr. Schaefer and Mr. Hagemeyer present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The minutes of June 13, 2022 were mailed to the Trustees prior to the meeting for review. Warrants 11710 through 11727 totaling \$10,038.62 were presented for approval.

Mr. Hagemeyer made a motion, seconded by Mr. Schaefer to approve the minutes for the May 9, 2022 regular meeting. Fisher, aye; Schaefer, aye; Hagemeyer, aye. Motion passed.

A motion to pay the bills was made by Mr. Schaefer and seconded by Mr. Hagemeyer. Fisher, aye; Schaefer, aye; Hagemeyer, aye. Motion passed.

Present for the meeting were: Tim Books, Emilie Fisher, Robert and Marilyn Portman.

FROM THE FLOOR: Mr. and Mrs. Portman asked what Little Miami Gig will be offering. The board explained that they will offer fiber optic internet services and have already started installations in Washington Township.

ROADS REPORT: Mr. Stanforth reported:

- He and Todd Bailey finished working on the culvert at the intersection of Arrowcreek and Sentinel Court. He said that all the residents at Sentinel Court were good to work with and wanted to thank Paul for letting them use his 277B Cat Skid Steer on the job.
- He would like to get a couple quotes to take down a tree on Ward Koebel Road and stated that the road will need to be closed during the process.
- Also, while working on the culvert he discovered a small leak on the 2015 Truck and would like to get it to Freightliner for repairs on a rusted transmission line.
- We have received more ditching requests from residents

OLD BUSINESS:

- Mr. Hagemeyer reported that Little Miami Gig is heading into Arrowcreek for installations for fiber optic at this time. They seem to be going back and forth to different places.
- Mr. Fisher stated that he has had no updates on the Strout Road Speed Study.
- Mr. Fisher has not received any information from Adam Nice, Warren County Prosecutor's Office, concerning commenting on Liquor Licenses, but no new complaints have been received from neighbors of Little River Bar and Grill.
- Mr. Hagemeyer commented that the Bed and Breakfast had opened across the road from Little River Bar and Grill.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Ms. Coffman and the Trustees discussed the upcoming 2023 budget. Allen presented his budget request for roads. Nothing on the Township Hall at this time as prices for repairs are high currently. But in the future, we will look into possibilities. If AARP Funds are not able to be used in broadband connections for the Township we will discuss possible uses for building repair.
- Mr. Schaefer stated that the Southwest Regional Training is October 31, 2022. And the Warren County EMA will host the K105 Public Info Training on September 19, 20, and 21, 2022 from 8-5.
- Mr. Fisher reported that the Warren County Regional Planning Commission Quarterly Meeting has been cancelled due to no agenda items.
- The Wedding Venue on Wilmington Road is progressing.

A motion was made by Mr. Schaefer and seconded by Mr. Hagemeyer to adjourn at 7:35 PM.
