

Record of Proceedings – November 14, 2022
Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by President Jason Fisher with Mr. Schaefer present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The minutes of October 24, 2022 were mailed to the Trustees prior to the meeting for review. Warrants 11831 through 11838 totaling \$10,947.88 were presented for approval.

FROM THE FLOOR:

- Emilie Fisher was present at the meeting to bring attention to Washington Township residents that part of the township is included in the watershed. There are state and federal monies available if anyone knows of residents that need some help. OLD BUSINESS:

- Mr. Fisher reminded everyone that the Amberger Rezoning Hearing is November 29, 2022 at 6:30 PM at the Warren County Commissioners Office.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Mr. Schaefer reported that the CWJFD is still trying to get 3 full time employees for the department. The board is working on grants to cover salaries. They had 73 EMS runs and 40 Fire runs this period.

Ms. Coffman said that she had sent an email to the Governor's Office requesting information about the First Responder's Wellness Grant.

- Mr. Fisher stated that Mr. Hagemeyer had received a call about the ongoing drainage problem on Senior Road. Mr. Hagemeyer has called Melissa Clark at ODNR to see if they can clean out the pipe.
- Mr. Fisher stated that the Warren County Regional Planning Quarterly meeting is the 15th at 5:30 PM. He will be attending.
- Mr. Fisher stated that Michelle Tegtmeier has had some issues reported to her concerning Little River Café including a private wooded camping venue where the old house on the north side was, someone is living in the little shed in the woods, and a problem with multiple campers in the parking lots. The Zoning Office is on top of the matter.
