

Record of Proceedings – April 24, 2023
Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The meeting was called to order by President Paul Schaefer at 7:00 PM. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The minutes of April 10, 2023 were mailed to the Trustees prior to the meeting for review. Warrants 11948 through 11966 totaling \$9,793.75 were presented for approval.

Motion was made by Mr. Fisher to approve the minutes for the April 10, 2023 regular meeting, Mr. Hagemeyer seconded. Schaefer, aye; Hagemeyer, aye; Fisher, aye. Motion passed.

A motion to pay the bills was made by Mr. Hagemeyer and seconded by Mr. Fisher. Schaefer, aye; Hagemeyer, aye; Fisher, aye. Motion passed.

Present for the meeting were: Tim Books, Jake Henry, and Fred Carmack.

FROM THE FLOOR: Nothing

ROADS REPORT: Mr. Stanforth reported:

- Warren County did not receive any bids for the chip seal program. They are rewriting the bid and will find out early in May if any bids come in. Allen spoke directly with Miller Mason and they stated they would revisit the possibility of bidding the projects. If they do not bid they may give us a direct bid for our projects.
- Todd Bailey will be available to work on May 5th. He and Allen will replace a culvert on Settlemyre Road.
- The tractors are both ready for mowing.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Mr. Schaefer reminded everyone that the Wayne Township Tire Recycle Event will be April 29, 2023 from 9 AM to 12 PM at 5238 N. Waynesville Road.
- Mr. Hagemeyer reported that there have been no new updates concerning the property of Todd Blackschleger of 7276 Shawhan Ayers Road, Clarksville. The Trustees agreed that the property condition has improved immensely since the Warren County Health Department issued a warning to get the place cleaned up.
- Mr. Fisher reported that he received an email from Tom and Julie Kozel of 9379 Arrowhead Lane complaining about ongoing problems from the neighbor at 7890 SR 350. This issue has been looked in to by The Warren County Zoning Office. Mr. Fisher called the Zoning Office and was told that the owners are moving the equipment from the property at this time. He has responded to the Kozels with this information.

- Mr. Hagemeyer stated Trebel LLC., will be sending out the opt-out letters to residents that do not wish to participate in the Township Aggregation Program.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Mr. Schaefer reported that the CWJFD had 76- EMS Runs and 39 Fire Runs during the last period. The Department was awarded a Legacy Grant of \$56,000.00 to use for equipment only. A contract was signed for the Safer Grant, the money will be received in January 2024. An anonymous donor gave the Department \$40,000.00 and they will use it to build a new building to hold equipment. They are still in need of a Legal Advisor. Mr. Fisher will try to contact Mr. Bruce McGary again to see if he is interested. Rob Kaufman is also a possibility.
- Mr. Schaefer stated that he has been contacted by Spectrum several times for internet service. So they are in the area and ready to hook customers up.
- Mr. Hagemeyer asked Ms. Coffman about the ARP Project and Expenditure Report that is due by the end of the month. Ms. Coffman stated that it has already been done.

A motion was made by Mr. Hagemeyer and seconded by Mr. Fisher to adjourn at 7:25 PM.
