

**Record of Proceedings – July 10, 2023**  
**Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio**

The meeting was called to order by President Paul Schaefer at 7:00 PM with Scott Hagemeyer and Jason Fisher present. Also present were Sharon Coffman, Fiscal Officer, and Allen Stanforth, Roads Supervisor.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The minutes of June 26, 2023 were mailed to the Trustees prior to the meeting for review. Warrants 12028 through 12034 totaling \$3,784.47 were presented for approval.

FROM THE FLOOR:

- John Boyd asked if the Trustees have any control over Little Miami Gig. They are leaving holes, blocking driveways, parking on easements, and leaving equipment all over the Township. The Trustees said they have no control over them but Mr. Fisher will be happy to call and speak with Chase Struna.
- David Brausch wanted to let everyone know that he has purchased the Dare Junkyard property and is planning on cleaning it up and moving his business to part of it and possibly Do It Right Excavating will move their business there also.
- Chris Brausch stated that Barry Riley is running for Warren County Sherriff.

ROADS REPORT: Mr. Stanforth reported:

- The culvert at the cell tower entrance on Lincoln Road needs replaced. The Trustees asked Ms. Coffman to send a letter to Ignac & Maria Pereznegron asking them to call Allen Stanforth to explain the process to them.
- Mr. Fisher stated that the culvert replacement on Ross Road looks good.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Mr. Fisher stated there are no updates concerning the property at 2425 Gum Grove Road. The owner is deceased and the property needs cleanup. Mr. Stanforth said that someone has mowed and it looks pretty good.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Mr. Schaefer stated that the Township received an email from Kendall Phillips with Trimble Maps requesting any kind of paper maps, text files, Arcview shapefiles detailing legal and/or restricted truck routes in Washington Township. The Trustees asked Ms. Coffman to reply back that they will need to contact ODOT and Dominic Brigano at the Warren County Engineer's Office for the requested information.
